2010 BENCHMARK EVENTS AS AT 15 FEBRUARY 2011

Assumptions

All Benchmark results are based on Olympic events on the 2012 Olympic Program.

Athletics

No suitable benchmark event in 2010. Results are based on the Athletics Weekly Magazine issued 30 December 2010. Please note that the men's hammer throw results are based on the IAAF website as at 26 January 2011.

Badminton

At the 2010 BWF World Championships there is no play off for the bronze medal. The Medal Tally records multiple bronze medal winners. The results have been Olympic adjusted based on maximum NOC quota.

Boxing - Men

No suitable benchmark event in 2010. The results from the 2009 World Championships are used as the benchmark event in 2010. There is no play off for the bronze medal at the World Championships. The Medal Tally records multiple bronze medal winners.

Boxing - Women

Results taken from three of the ten World Championships weight divisions that closely match to the Olympic weight divisions for women.

At the World Championships there is no play off for the bronze medal. The Medal Tally records multiple bronze medal winners.

Cycling Track

The results have been Olympic adjusted based on maximum NOC quota.

Fencing

At the 2010 World Fencing Championships, there is no play off for the bronze medal in the individual events. The Medal Tally records multiple bronze medal winners.

Football

Men – No suitable benchmark event in 2010. The results from the 2009 Under 20 World Cup are used as the benchmark event in 2010.

Women – No suitable benchmark event in 2010. Please note that FIFA do not publish the Women's World Ranking as at 31 December 2010. The results recorded are based on the last 2010 FIFA Women's World Ranking as at 19 November 2010.

Handball

No suitable benchmark event in 2010. The results from the 2009 World Championships are used as the benchmark event in 2010.

Judo

If nations won multiple medals in the same weight category, only the highest ranked medal has been recorded on the medal tally. The results have been Olympic adjusted based on maximum NOC quota.

Swimming

No suitable benchmark event in 2010. The results from Swimming Australia's Virtual World Ranking (Commonwealth Games, Pan Pacific Championships and European Championships) are used as the benchmark event in 2010.

Marathon Swimming – The VI FINA World Open Water Swimming Championships held in Roberval, Canada, 15 July 2010.

Table Tennis

Singles – no suitable benchmark event in 2010. The singles results from the 2009 World Individual Championships are used as the benchmark event in 2010.

At the 2009 World Individual Table Tennis Championships there is no play off for the bronze medal. The results have been Olympic adjusted based on maximum NOC quota. The Medal Tally records multiple bronze medal winners.

Taekwondo

No suitable benchmark event in 2010. The results from the 2009 WTF World Taekwondo Championships are used as the benchmark event in 2010. The 2010 WTF World Cup Taekwondo Team Championships competition format does not replicate the competition format of the Olympic Games.

At the 2009 WTF World Taekwondo Championships there is no play off for the bronze medal. The Medal Tally records multiple bronze medal winners.

Tennis

Medals won in the mixed, men's and women's doubles by partners of different nationality are not represented on the medal tally.
